Villa Kokkonen is a historic home designed by architect Alvar Aalto. Finished in 1969 on the shore of Lake Tuusula. Villa Kokkonen aims to connect nature and human everyday life with two forms of art: music and architecture. The highlight of the tour is always a concert in the atelier by the caretakers of the house, pianist Elina Viitaila and opera singer Antti A. Pesonen.
