
FINNISH DESIGN AND HOSPITALITY

Guided tours & Concerts

Villa Kokkonen is Alvar Aalto's masterpiece (1969), the youngest house of Lake Tuusula artist community and a year-round attraction.

Since 2009, pianist Elina Viitaila and opera singer Antti A. Pesonen occypy the house, cherishing the cultural heritage of the villa and hosting guided tours which culminate in musical performances by the couple.

HOME FOR MUSIC

Villa Kokkonen is the only private house Alvar Aalto dedicated to music. That's why both exterior and interior have been influenced by a delicate connection between music and architecture.

Travertine marble on the floor, Oregon pine on the wall, a huge white canvas on the ceiling and 30 lamps above the canvas guarantee the functioning of a 70 square meter atelier as an excellent concert hall for classical music.

It was Aalto's main intention and passion to build an authentic "Home for Music", the heart of which is an acoustic space conducing to the best possible musical output.

ARTISTIC GUIDED TOURS

Elina Viitaila and Antti A. Pesonen take care, on daily basis, of Villa Kokkonen's valuable heritage revolving around Finnish architecture and music. Their artistic guided tours are easily available by appointment for individual visitors and groups throughout the year.

During summer most of the tours are open to the public.

Guided tours hosted by Elina and Antti showcase Alvar Aalto's architecture in so many ways possible. There is, for example, in the forest garden a special 360-degree route which has been designed to serve the needs of architects, students of architecture and every person interested in studying or enjoying Alvar Aalto's work of art.

Since Alvar Aalto designed Villa Kokkonen for music, one highlight of every tour is Elina's and Antti's musical performance in the gorgeous acoustics of the atelier.

CONCERTS

Villa Kokkonen is a perfect place for concerts. Elina Viitaila and Antti A. Pesonen arrange not only several concerts which are open to the public, but they can also give an unforgettable private concert for a group of more than 10 persons.
